

4. Prizes:  
 a.) All students who participate and turn in a reading log will receive a participation prize in the fall. We will have a Pop Party to celebrate our reading; the party is tentatively scheduled for Friday, September 25<sup>th</sup>.  
 b.) Students who read a minimum of 10 books will receive at least 1 new book next spring.  
 c.) There will be an awards assembly in the fall to recognize the top three readers in each grade level; the assembly is tentatively scheduled for Friday, September 25<sup>th</sup>.  
 d.) The top primary (K-3) and intermediate (4-6) readers in the school will have their names engraved on the plaque and their pictures in the library.  
 e.) If the total number of books read by the entire school reaches 13,000, there will be a special award for everyone who turned in a reading log.
